**Attendance policy:**

Unit will be delivered during each academic semester on 16 Weeks, student can absent up to 3 sessions, pass mark will give to student if attendance form has more than 5 sessions and he take minimum pass in all assignments.

**Assessment Marks policy:**

- Assessor should publish and inform student their assignment or exam after 48 hours and not executed one week of submission end date.

**Internal Verifier policy:**

- For IV1 Assessor will send to IV before one week of assignment week as academic calendar.
- For IV2 Assessor will send students results during assignment week as academic calendar and on the day that the teacher publish results to student with one week if updated needed.

**For Resubmission opportunity:**

An assignment provides the final assessment for the relevant learning outcomes and is normally a final assessment decision. A student who, for the first assessment opportunity, has failed to achieve a Pass for that unit specification shall be expected to undertake a reassessment.

- Only one opportunity for reassessment of the unit will be permitted.
- A student who undertakes a reassessment will have their grade capped at a Pass for that unit.
- A student will not be entitled to be reassessed in any component of assessment for which a Pass grade or higher has already been awarded.

**For Repeat Unit:**

A student who, for the first assessment opportunity and resubmission opportunity, still failed to achieve a Pass for that unit specification:

- The student must study the unit again with full attendance and payment of the unit fee (300\$).
- Units can only be repeated once.
